

PPG Minutes of 3rd January 2018 Meeting

- Welcome SB opened the meeting and wished everyone a Happy and Healthy New Year
- CQC Visit SB informed the meeting that due to surgery staffing issues the CQC visit had been rescheduled for Friday 2nd February 2018. It would be helpful if any PPG members who were free would attend the surgery on that date in case the CQC wished to speak with them. MV indicated that he would be away on that date and SB promised to send a reminder prior to the 2nd Feb to all members.
- Staffing SB provided an update on recent staff changes, new members of reception staff are Kim and Sam. The meeting was also informed that, with regret, Dr. Best will be retiring at the end of March but that Dr. Ali (a previous GP registrar) would be joining the Surgery on the 2nd Feb. The meeting discussed the pressure currently being felt by all the surgery staff which is not being helped by the number of new patients joining the practice as a consequence of the large new housing developments at Tollgate and adjacent to the London Road.
